

# Women Leaders Deliver More.




To tackle the toughest problems that face our nation today, having diverse leadership will be key.



While women now comprise more than half of U.S. college graduates, they are still vastly under-represented at the highest levels of leadership.

Data on women in leadership was reviewed across 14 sectors. Select results follow.




## Academia

Women win 55.88% of the most prestigious awards, despite only holding 29.1% of tenure track positions.

## Arts & Entertainment

In 2011, women penned 60% of the best sellers yet captured only about 27% of the earnings.



## Business

Businesses with women on their boards outperform companies with all-male boards by 26%.

## Journalism

Of the 25 largest daily newspapers in the U.S., only 1 can report that they have a woman publisher.





## K-12 Education

Head of the class, not of the school: women average 75% of teaching positions but only 30% of the leadership roles.

## Law

In 2012, women were 46.7% of law school graduates; yet only 15% of equity partners and 5% of managing partners.



## Military

The Armed Services was one of the first employers to salute women by giving them equal pay back in 1901.

## Sports

At Division 1 schools, female coaches earn 68% of what the males make, one of the largest pay gaps in this study.
