AN ACT to amend the environmental conservation law, in relation to the preparation of an economic impact statement prior to the enactment of any rule or regulation affecting the commercial fishing industry and providing for periodic review of such rules or regulations

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. The environmental conservation law is amended by adding a
2 new section 13-0365 to read as follows:

3 § 13-0365. Economic impact statements.

4 1. All rules and regulations affecting the commercial fishing industry, promulgated pursuant to this title, shall be subject to the
5 provisions of this section.

6 2. Prior to the adoption of any proposed rule or regulation, the
7 department shall prepare an economic impact statement that includes at
8 least the following analysis:

9 (a) an identification and estimate of the number of the members of the
10 commercial fishing industry affected by the proposed rule or regulation;

11 (b) the administrative costs to the commercial fishing industry
12 required for compliance with the proposed rule or regulation;

13 (c) a statement of the probable economic effect of the rule or regu-
14 lation on the commercial fishing industry, including but not limited to
15 loss of income and jobs; and

16 (d) a discussion of any less intrusive or less costly alternative
17 methods of achieving the purpose of the proposed rule or regulation, in

1 order to mitigate adverse economic impact to the commercial fishing
2 industry.

3 3. (a) Within two years of the effective date of this section, the
4 department shall review all rules and regulations under this title
5 existing at the time of enactment to determine whether such rules or
6 regulations shall be continued without change, or should be amended or
7 rescinded to minimize economic impact on the commercial fishing indus-
8 try.

9 (b) Rules adopted after the effective date of this section shall be
10 reviewed every two years after the publication of such rules as the
11 final rule to ensure that they minimize economic impact on the commer-
12 cial fishing industry in a manner consistent with the stated objectives
13 of this title.

14 (c) In reviewing rules or regulations to minimize economic impact on
15 the commercial fishing industry, the department shall consider the
16 following factors:

17 (i) the need for the rule or regulation;

18 (ii) the nature of complaints or comments received concerning the rule
19 or regulation from the commercial fishing industry;

20 (iii) the complexity of the rule; and

21 (iv) the degree to which economic conditions, or other factors have
22 changed since the original enactment of the rule or regulation.

23 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
