

YOUNG STUDENTS SUMMER PROGRAM IN MARINE SCIENCES

Two 2-week marine science courses on the nature of Long Island's coastal marine environment are being offered this summer at the Marine Sciences Research Center (MSRC) of the University at Stony Brook.

Each course will offer hands-on learning experiences, with an emphasis on field trips to a variety of marine habitats, both on the north and south shores. Students will collect specimens and then examine and identify the collected specimens in the laboratory, cataloging them according to habitat. Students will use their field notes and laboratory findings to characterize each habitat, taking into consideration the adaptations of the organisms that survive in that habitat. The types of coastal environments that the students will study include rocky beach, tidal marsh, barrier beach, and open coastal waters.

The students will have access to the MSRC's 60' research vessel, the R/V ONRUST; marine sample collecting equipment, including plankton nets, bottom grabs, and water sampling devices; they will use the Center's facilities at Flax Pond, a tidal marsh located 7 miles from campus, and the laboratories at the MSRC campus; and will be taught by MSRC faculty and graduate students. Each student who completes the course will receive a certificate of achievement.

First Session

For students aged 9 through 12: Course period: Mon. through Fri. 9:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m. July 8 through July 19, 1991

Second Session

For students aged 13 through 17: Course period: Mon. through Fri. 9:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m. July 22 through August 2

Students will be expected to bring the following items each day:

- their own lunches and drinks (water will be provided by the staff on all trips);
- 2. sun protection (hat, sunscreen, sunglasses, long sleeved shirt);
- 3. notebook and pencils;
- 4. other items as specified by the course instructor.

Parents have the option to either provide their own transportation, or to use the van service provided by the program to transport students from home to the Marine Sciences Research Center and back. Van transportation will be available at an additional cost. Transportation from the Marine Sciences Research Center to field trip locations will be provided by the program as part of the basic program cost.

Basic two-week program cost (without van service): \$450.00

Two-week program cost plus van transportation

\$575.00

All applicants will be interviewed prior to being accepted into the program. Only those students who are genuinely interested in an intensive, rewarding learning experience in marine sciences will be accepted. Enrollment for each session will be limited to a maximum of 30 students.
