This hat of super-soft lion Cashmere blend with a delicate stripe of red and white hearts matches the [Queen of Hearts Receiving blanket](#) pattern. Note that this pattern can be made from the amount of yarn that is left from making the blanket.

### Queen of Hearts Preemie / Newborn Hat

Pattern Number: 60072

**SKILL LEVEL:** Advanced Beginner

**SIZE:** Preemie, Newborn

Approximately 10 (12) inches [25 (30) cm](hat stretches)

**Note:** Pattern is written for smallest size with changes for larger sizes in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

**CORRECTIONS:** (applied Mar 22, 2006)

#### HAT

**Rows 1-12** \*K2, p2. Repeat from \* to end of row

#### MATERIALS

- 270-098 Lion Brand Lion Cashmere Blend: Cream  
1 Skeins (A) One skein will make 2 hats
- 270-113 Lion Brand Lion Cashmere Blend: Red  
1 Skeins (B) Very small quantity used
- Lion Brand Knitting Needles- Size 8 [5 mm]
- Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

#### GAUGE:

17 sts + 25 rows = 4 in [10 cm] in Stockinette st (k on RS, p on WS) BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

#### HAT

With A, cast on 48 (56) stitches

**Rows 1-11** \*K2, p2. Repeat from \* to end of row

**Row 12** K2, p2tog across - 36 (42) sts

**Rows 13-20** Work in St st, beg with a RS row.

#### Red 'hearts' stripe

**Row 21** Change to B, knit

**Row 22** \*P1 B, p1 A. Repeat from \* to end of row.

**Row 23** Change to B, knit

**Row 24-29 (33)** Change to A, work in St st.

**Row 30 (34)** \*P4, p2tog. Repeat from \* to end of row - 30 (35) sts

**Row 31 (35) and all RS rows** Knit

**Row 32 (36)** \*P3, p2tog. Repeat from \* to end of row - 24 (28) sts

**Row 34 (38)** \*P2, p2tog. Repeat from \* to end of row - 18 (21) sts

**Row 36 (40)** \*P1, p2tog. Repeat from \* to end of row - 12 (14) sts

**Row 38 (42)** P2tog across - 6 (7) sts

**Row 40 (44)** P0 (1), p2tog across -3 (4) sts Cut yarn, leaving a 16 inch [40 cm] tail. Thread tail through remaining sts, and sew the sides of the hat together. Fasten off securely. Weave in ends.

#### POM-POM

Cut a strip of cardboard the size you want your pompom to be. With one strand each A and B, wrap yarn around cardboard – the more wraps, the fuller the pompom will be. Cut yarn leading to skein. Slide a doubled strand of yarn under center of wraps and knot. Clip loops; remove cardboard. Fluff pompom and trim ends evenly. Use the ends of the knotted strand to attach pompom to top of hat.
